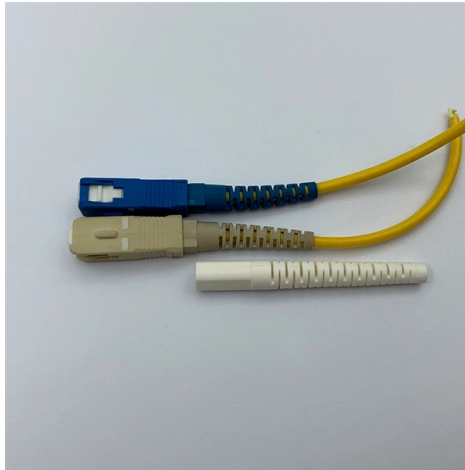


Cable tray connection bolt specifications



Overview

The fittings can be fastened to the cable tray rail either with double clamps of type DOP A2 or with truss-head bolts of type FRS and combination nuts. The exceptions to this are vertical bends, adjustable bend elements and fittings with a side height of 35 mm. The Ladder Tray features light, rugged, tubular steel construction. It is designed for use when completely installed, without damage either to conductors or structural system use maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is bent. The minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when used without notice.
