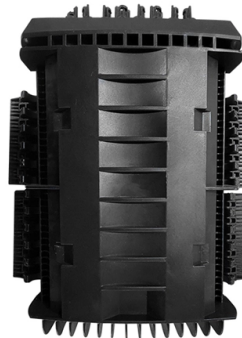


# Configuration of Aggregation Switch Primary and Backup Machines



## Overview
