This method uses rivets to join busbars by creating holes in the bars and securing them together. It offers a tight and cost-effective joint. In Simple words, a bus-bar is a common connection point or a node for multiple incoming and outgoing circuits such as power lines or feeders. Hence we use bus bars, where these connections can be done spaciouly and.
