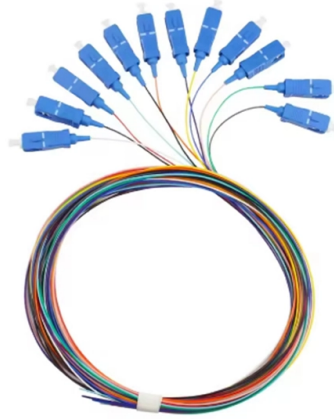


Fiber optic cable open



Overview

In this video, I demonstrate how I partially open a 144-count OSP fiber optic cable by removing only the outer jacket and metallic armor, without accessing the buffer tubes or fibers. The process focuses on controlled jacket and armor removal to safely expose the cable core during. Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up. They should have caulked it, but probably was not necessary. The line will last for a while, but allowing rainwater to get in that conduit is going.
