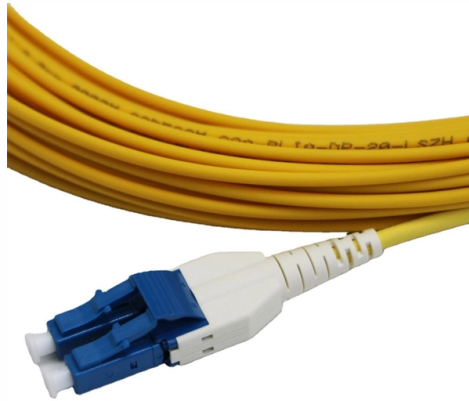


How are fiber optic cables laid on highways
