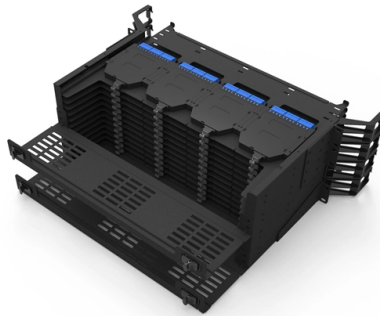


How to wire series circuits in a distribution box
