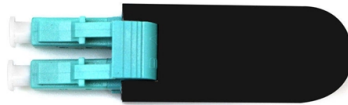
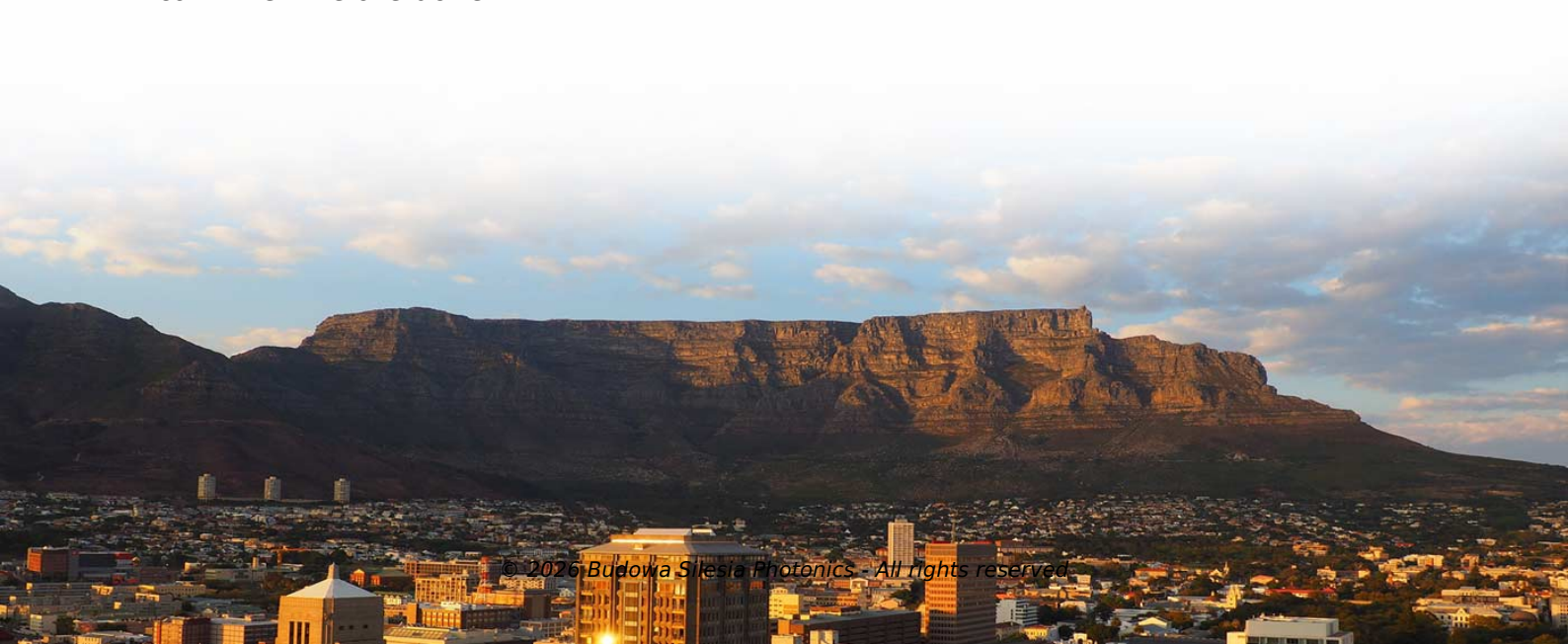


Location of network patch panel and switch

Here's a really simple topology: network drops > patch panel > patch cables > switch ports > single patch cable, not connected to the patch panel, between switch and router/gateway (typically). And a diagram (image credit christopherjthomas). If you have an existing patch panel the short answer to “can I just plug in a cable into the front of it” is yes.
